

The Title of a Church

From 'Church Building and Furnishing, the Church's Way'

Each consecration or solemnly blessed church has its title or Titular [feast], *i.e.*, the person, mystery or sacred object, in whose name the church has been founded, in whose honor it is dedicated and after whom it is called. Every church or oratory is dedicated to God, but it may be dedicated also *in honor* of another. This has been the Church's practice from the 4th or 5th century. The Title is named by the Bishop when laying the foundation stone of the church, and is irrevocably constituted when the church is consecrated or solemnly blessed. In this rite, as at the laying of the foundation stone, the Title is mentioned in the prayers and in the Litanies of the Saints, and Mass is celebrated in his honor. His name is also mentioned in the attestation of the consecration. Once the Title has been fixed by the consecration or solemn blessing of the church, it may not be changed without Apostolic indult.

In general, any person, mystery or sacred thing that may be the object of public veneration [according to the rules of the Church] may be chosen as Title, and so the Blessed Trinity, or one of the Divine Persons [excepting the Heavenly Father, for Whom there is no feast, Mass nor office in the calendar], Our Lady under any title, the angels, or any named angel [such as St. Michael]; any canonized saint mentioned in the Roman Martyrology, or in the approved calendar of any diocese or religious Order; or any mystery (the Incarnation, the Blessed Eucharist); or a sacred object (the Holy Cross) or event (the Conversion of St. Paul) may be chosen as Title. ...Each Title will have the same liturgical privileges: ...the Title is celebrated as first class [and formerly had an octave]. If the Title is our Divine Saviour, its special feast is that of the Transfiguration; if a Title of Our Lady without a special feast in the calendar, the Assumption. The Title of a Cathedral is celebrated by all churches throughout the diocese. The feast of the Title of the greater Roman basilicas (e.g., St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major's, etc.) is celebrated throughout the Universal Church.
