

Sacramental Protocols at OLGS

Baptisms: Notify the pastor of the birth of the child, so a time can be set aside for the baptism. The baptism should take place no more than 1-2 weeks after birth if possible. Certificates are usually given immediately following the baptism.

First Communions: First communions will take place sometime in the spring (usually May), and are preceded by a test given by the pastor. The child should also make at least one or two confessions before receiving their first holy communion. Each candidate must provide a baptismal certificate, if not baptized at Our Lady of Good Success.

Confirmations: Every other year, when a sufficient number of candidates (at least having received their first communion, and been sufficiently instructed) have been gathered, one of the bishops of the Society of St. Pius X will be contacted to ascertain his availability to come and perform the ceremony. This will be arranged through the District House of the SSPX, and subject to the schedule for the entire district. Required certificates: baptism (if not baptized at OLGS), and first communion.

Marriage: More than six months before the expected time of marriage, contact the pastor. Set up a time to meet with him, and provide a recently issued baptismal certificate, and certificates for first communion and confirmation. The various forms and affidavits will be provided by the pastor. Then, the couple will arrange with him to meet for at least five lessons in preparation for the sacrament.

Extreme Unction: when someone has a life-threatening illness, condition or injury, or is weakened by old age, the pastor should be contacted sooner than later: immediately if an emergency. It is best to receive this sacrament when the person is awake and aware, able to form good dispositions of soul. Please do not wait until the final moments! If the anointing can be given at the church, it is best.

Sick calls: Confession and communion can be given to someone who is too infirm to attend Mass. In the home or room of the person, it is important to prepare a clean surface, with candles burning (where permitted), and a crucifix clearly visible to the infirm person. If communion will be given, a small bowl with a little water for the purification of the fingers is also helpful, and a glass of water for the candidate to help swallow the sacred species if thought necessary. The priest must be met at the door with a lit candle and a small bell if available. The household must be silent and all recollected.

Sacramental Certificates: These may be requested from the pastor at any time. A reason is required (approaching further sacraments, moving to another location, etc.).

Candidates to the seminary or novitiates: set aside some time to discuss the possibility of your vocation with the pastor. Advice on this big step can also be given briefly to a person in the confessional. The pastor will direct each applicant regarding the steps to be taken, and the contacts to be made in each case. A letter of recommendation will have to be provided by the pastor.
