Announcements

Monthly Events: the after-Mass events will take place on their respective Sundays this month as usual.

Ascension Thursday: Although this Traditional Holy Day is not observed, except in only a handful of dioceses throughout the US, it is good for us to keep the spirit of the Holy Day as best we can.

May Crowning: will take place Sunday, May 3, before the Mass. Children may be assembled in the vestibule to follow the Priest and the altar servers in procession to the statue on the North Side of the chapel, where they may deposit their roses into the vases provided. One young lady who will come last will carry the crown and place it upon the head of Our Lady. The crowned statue will remain in the sanctuary until the end of the month of May. It is also customary, throughout this month, for families to include the Litany of Our Lady with the recitation of the family Rosary.

May 14th - Ascension of Our Lord: Holy hour will begin at 6pm at OLGS.
